

The City Council of the City of Robertsdale, Alabama met Monday, July 18 2005 at 8:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of Robertsdale City Hall, that being the date, time and place for such meeting.

Upon roll call, the following members of the Council were found to be present: Mayor Murphy, Councilmember Kitchens, Cooper, Grant, Kendrick, and Hollingsworth. A quorum being present the meeting proceeded with the transaction of business.

Mayor Murphy presided over the meeting. Shannon Ellison served as secretary. Ken Raines, City Attorney, was also in attendance.

Motion was made by Councilmember Grant, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented.

Mayor Murphy called for questions regarding the bills presented for approval. There being no questions, motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Hollingsworth, with unanimous approval to accept the bills as presented. APPENDIX I

Mayor Murphy closed the regular order of business and opened the public hearing on a rezoning request made by Myrtle Harrison. The Planning Commission had denied the request to rezone the property on State Highway 104 and Palmer Street from R-2 to B-2. Ms. Darby, representative for Mrs. Harrison explains the need for Mrs. Harrison to sell the property, and is aware that the neighbors are upset with not knowing who will purchase the property.

Mayor Murphy stated that an ad solicitation has been presented to the Council from Community Action Agency. The booklet ads range from \$25.00 to \$100.00 depending on the size ad. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked if this was the first time the agency has requested participation from the City for this booklet. Mayor Murphy stated that in fact it was. Councilmember Grant made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Kitchens to deny this request. Motion carried

Mayor Murphy then called for action on the recommendation of the Planning Commission to deny the request to rezone Ms. Harrison's property at State Hwy 104 and Palmer Street. Motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, seconded by Councilmember Grant, to suspend the rulings. Motion of action on rezoning request made by the Planning Commission to deny this request. Motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, seconded by Councilmember Kitchens to deny this request. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy stated next on the agenda was Ordinance No. 05-05. Mayor Murphy explained this Ordinance was to clarify "rubbish" with additions and expansion of the definition. Motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, seconded by Councilmember Kendrick, that all rules unless suspended would prevent immediate passage and adoption of Ordinance, at this meeting and the same passed and adopted by unanimous vote of the Council.

Motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to approve Ordinance No. 05-05. Motion carried. APPENDIX II
