The City Council of the City of Robertsdale, Alabama met Monday, April 15, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of Robertsdale City Hall, that being the date, time and place for such meeting.

Upon roll call, the following members of the Council were found to be present: Councilmember Kitchens, Campbell, Johnson, and Hollingsworth. Absent: Mayor Murphy and Councilmember Cooper. A quorum being present the meeting proceeded with the transaction of business.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens presided over the meeting. Shannon Burkett served as secretary. Ken Raines, City Attorney was also in attendance.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens called for any additions or corrections to the minutes presented for approval from the April 1, 2024 meeting. Motion was made by Councilmember Campbell, seconded by Councilmember Hollingsworth, with unanimous approval to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens asked for questions or comments regarding the bills presented for approval. There being none, motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, and seconded by Councilmember Campbell, with unanimous approval to accept the bills as presented. Motion carried. APPENDIX I

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens closed the regular order of business and opened the public hearing as scheduled on the rezoning request made by LL & T Properties, from B-2 to I-1, for the property located on the south side of Highway 104, approximately 920 feet west of State Highway 59.

Greg Smith, City Engineer, mentioned that this property is on the south side of Highway 104 just west of Highway 104 Mobile Home Park. He explained that the applicant is requesting to rezone the property from B-2 to I-1 to allow for a beverage distribution warehouse. Mr. Smith stated that the Planning Commission has reviewed this application and recommended that the rezoning be approved. Mrs. Lee Racine, with Racine's Feed, Garden & Supply Inc, asked for clarification on the exact location and provided with the information she was concern about. The representative from LL & T Properties explained that the hours of operation will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Councilmember Hollingsworth asked for clarification on I-1 zoning, and Mr. Smith explained that this is for light industrial, which is also the typical zoning in the Indistrial Park. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked how large the parcel is. The representative stated that the property is just under five acres and the warehouse is will be 16,000 square feet with around twelve employees accepting shipments during the regular business hours, and will not be used as a retail facility. Councilmember Campbell asked if Highway 104 would have to be widened, and the representative mentioned that the State Highway Department already has a plan due to some other developments in the area. With no further discussion, Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens closed the public hearing on this item and resumed the regular order of business.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens opened the public hearing as scheduled on the rezoning request made by BC Property Investments LLC for the property located at 24860 Highway 59, from R-1 to B-2.

Greg Smith, City Engineer, explained that this applicant is also requesting to annex this property, which would come in as R-1. He mentioned that the property is located across from the Middle School on the east side of Highway 59, and is currently zoned business with Baldwin County. Mr. Smith explained that the parcel across on the west side of Highway 59 is requesting to annex in as well, which will then make this property contiguous. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked if we can cross Highway 59, and Mr. Smith stated that you can cross a right-of-way. Ken Raines, City Attorney, asked that they make the vote subject to his review. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked what their intentions are for the property, and Brad Conquest, member of BC Property, stated that they have a rental facility to rent equipment and they also manufacture golf carts. With no further discussion, Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens closed the public hearing on this item and resumed the regular order of business.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens stated that the next item on the agenda is the Baldwin County Board of Education request to use the City property on Fairground Road, which was tabled from the last meeting.

Joe Sharp, Assistant Superintendent over secondary schools, along with Randy Sanks, Construction Coordinator, provided the Council with a packet of information of ongoing and proposed future projects at Robertsdale High School. Randy Sanks reviewed the information with the Council noting the second gym, indoor practice facility, band area and new parking. He mentioned that Sawgrass has included an estimated construction cost of a practice field and a price to resurface the track.

Councilmember Hollingsworth mentioned that since the practice field was taken away due to the construction, and the request was tabled until today for the City to negotiate the proper development of the City property. He thanked the Council for allowing him to pursue his dream of an on-campus football stadium at Robertsdale High School, and he thanked the School Board for meeting with the City to try to figure out what the best plan would be for the use of this property. Councilmember Hollingsworth explained that Mayor Murphy suggested that the City would build practice fields on that property and the Board of Education agreed to install irrigation on the practice fields and the important thing is that one of those fields would be dedicated to the school for their practice field and the others would be for City use. Mr. Sharp affirmed that everyone was in agreement on how to maximum the use of that property. After discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, and seconded by Councilmember Campbell, to allow Mayor Murphy to pursue the development of the practice fields on the City property on Fairground Road in conjunction with working with the Board of Education to develop a practice field. Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens asked for any discussion on the motion. Councilmember Johnson asked if the location of the practice field as drawn on the information provided was the agreed-on location. Mr. Sanks stated that it was more of a general location showing the physical size to establish a cost structure. Councilmember Johnson asked if they need a usage lease. Ken Raines, City Attorney, stated that he can address multiple options on how the City can handle it. Councilmember Hollingsworth mentioned that the City would build the fields and then dedicate one of them to the school. Greg Smith, City Engineer, suggested amending the motion to allow the Mayor and City Attorney to work out the details with the School Board on how to clarify that in writing. Councilmember Hollingsworth amended his motion to allow Mayor Murphy to pursue the development of the practice fields on the City property on Fairground Road in conjunction with working with the Board of Education to develop a practice field and allow the Mayor and City Attorney to work out the details with the School Board on how to dedicate the field, and Councilmember Campbell seconded the amended motion. Roger Booth, resident, wanted to make sure that the public could use the property for like soccer or anything if it is City property, and Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens mentioned that it is City property and the other fields will be open to the general public. Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous. Motion carried.

The Council received an ABC Event License for Cinco De Mayo at Pedros, located at 23177 Baldwin Farms Place. Motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, seconded by Councilmember Campbell, with unanimous approval of the ABC Event License for Cinco De Mayo at Pedros, located at 23177 Baldwin Farms Place. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kitchens stated that the next item on the agenda is the time change for the May 6<sup>th</sup> Council meeting due to the Top 10 Banquet. Motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, seconded by Councilmember Johnson, with unanimous approval to reschedule the Council meeting until Tuesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> at the same times. Motion carried.

The next item of business was the IT Management Proposal. Lewis Shealy, Chief Financial Officer, addressed the Council explaining that the City is seeking a proposal from TeamLogic IT for our technology services and will also help with an aspect of our insurance policy. Mr. Shealy explained that they would be City-wide and offer IT services, active monitoring, day to day operations, and troubleshooting by remote support and onsite support. After further discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, seconded by Councilmember Campbell, with unanimous approval to enter into the IT Management contract with TeamLogic IT for \$4,200 monthly. Motion carried.

Mr. Davis explained that he was concerned with the amount of recent rain and how much red clay ended up washing through to his back yard. Larry Pecht addressed the Council explaining that he lives on College Avenue behind where the new Forest Park development is planned and is concerned with the hours of construction in the ordinance for noise. He asked if there was anything they could do to modify the ordinance so that construction is between reasonable hours. Mayor Murphy explained that the City will look at addressing this issue with either the Noise Ordinance or through the Land Use Ordinance on the development aspect.

Councilmember Hollingsworth wanted it noted that the City of Robertsdale has the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall exhibit from May 9, 2024 through May 12, 2024, and is the only location in the State of Alabama. He mentioned that he is proud that Mayor Murphy worked to get it here.

MUNICIPAL WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION (MWPP) PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Robertsdale informs the Department of Environmental

Management that the following actions were taken by the City Council;

- 1. Reviewed the MWPP Annual Report which is attached to this resolution.
- 2. Set forth the following actions and schedule necessary to maintain effluent requirements contained in the NPDES Permit, and to prevent the bypass and overflow of raw sewage within the collection system or at the treatment plant:
  - (a) Continue to make repairs/replacements of sewer collection system as identified during the ongoing Comprehensive Sewer Main and Manhole inspections;
  - (b) City has been awarded a USDA Loan/Grant through Rural Development to increase capacity at the WWTP and also to increase capacity in Collection System to reduce the potential for Sanitary Sewer Overflows. Phase 1 (WWTP Upgrades) has begun construction, Phases 2 (Sludge Removal at waste pond) has begun and Phase 3 will be improvements to Collection System. Phase 3 is still in the plan development stage;
  - (c) City has been awarded an ADEM ARPA Clean Water Sewer Project to Repair/Rehab/Replace aged infrastructure in the Sewer System;
  - (d) Develop a Model of the Sewer System to better identify capacity issues and better plan for future growth in the sewer system;
  - (e) Apply for other Grant Funding available from various programs to make enhancements to the sewer treatment and collection systems.

Mayor Murphy called for any additions or corrections to the minutes presented for approval from the May 7, 2024 meeting. Motion was made by Councilmember Campbell, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy asked for questions or comments regarding the bills presented for approval. Councilmember Hollingsworth questioned the extrication tools listed from NAFECO for \$33,585.00 and asked if this is for the Fire Department. Mayor Murphy stated that it is. Lewis Shealey, Chief Financial Officer, explained that they periodically upgrade their extrication tools. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked what they do with the old ones, and Roger Booth, resident, mentioned that they send them to other departments. With no further discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, and seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to accept the bills as presented. Motion carried. APPENDIX I

Mayor Murphy opened the public hearing as scheduled on the rezoning request made by Brackin Holdings for the property located at 18608 Wilters Street, from R-1 to MU, which was recommended by the Planning Commission. James Brackin, with Brackin Holdings, was in attendance to address any questions.

It was discussed that Mr. Brackin operates a rental management company and will utilize this location for that business and use the warehouse to store additional building supplies. Councilmember Campbell clarified that they are not going to tear down the building, and Mr. Brackin assured her that they were not and talked about the history and what the building was used for in the past. Mayor Murphy called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous to support the Robertsdale High School Band with the \$2,500 annual contribution. Motion carried

The next item on the agenda is a request to designate July 5<sup>th</sup> as a gap holiday. Motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to observe Friday, July 5, 2024 as a gap holiday. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy stated that the next item of business is the renewal of the property and liability insurance. Lewis Shealy, Chief Financial Officer, addressed the Council explaining that this the for the annual renewal, and the overall policy has increased by about 15%. He mentioned that there was the addition of land, the new playground equipment and some new vehicles. Mr. Shealy recommended the option of the third year of the three-year policy as the renewal for \$262,681. After discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval of the option of the third year of the three-year policy as the renewal for \$262,681 with Blackmon Insurance. Motion carried.

The next item on the agenda is the annual contract extension request with Grant Management for \$32,000. Mayor Murphy mentioned that this is the second year on this contract and she has done a really good job for the City. Motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval of the annual contract extension with Grant Management for \$32,000. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy asked for any discussion on the motion. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked for clarification that this is a fundraiser for the special needs ballfield in Summerdale. Mrs. Marsh explained that just north of the tennis court in Summerdale there is a field area they have been working on for a while. She mentioned that they have completed the fully accessible playground structures and they are finishing the project with a ballfield complex for the special needs children. Councilmember Hollingsworth thanked Mrs. March and everyone involved in helping with this event. After further discussion, Mayor Murphy called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous to allow Exit Allstar Gulf Coast Realty the use of the billboard to promote the fundraising event for The Miracle League of Coastal Alabama on June 29, 2024 at the coliseum. Motion carried.

Brody King addressed the Council thanking them again for the assistance received for his Eagle Scout Project. He mentioned that on June 8<sup>th</sup> at Robertsdale Grace Community Church, there will be a ceremony for him earning his Eagle Scout Rank and invited the Council to attend.

The Council received an ad renewal request from Gulf Coast Media for Big Beautiful Baldwin. Motion was made by Councilmember Campbell, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to renew the \$1,099 full page ad in Big Beautiful Baldwin. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy stated that the next item on the agenda is to award the bid on the 2024 Tahoe for the Police Department. He mentioned that only one bid was received, from Donohoo Chevrolet, in the amount of \$49,894.00. Motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, and seconded by Councilmember Kitchens, to award the bid on the 2024 Tahoe for the Police Department to Donohoo Chevrolet in the amount of \$49,894.00. Mayor Murphy asked for any discussion on the motion. Councilmember Campbell asked if this was to fix it up, and Mayor Murphy explained that this is to purchase a new vehicle. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked for clarification that this is to purchase the vehicle and then they would have to get it equipped. Police Chief Kendrick stated that he was correct and it would probably be around \$25,000 to have it equipped. After further discussion, Mayor Murphy called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous to award the bid on the 2024 Tahoe for the Police Department to Donohoo Chevrolet in the amount of \$49,894.00. Motion carried.

The next item of business was a request from Jennifer Claire Moore Foundation. Mayor Murphy explained that they are requesting to use the billboard to promote their rodeo and also a \$500 advertising request. Motion was made by Councilmember Campbell, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to allow the Jennifer Claire Moore Foundation the use of the billboard to promote their rodeo and a \$500 advertising request. Motion carried.

For information, Mayor Murphy mentioned to the Council that they have received a copy of the concept work from WAS Design on the coliseum and asked them to review the information to see if there are any additional improvements they would like made, so that eventually they can have a total master plan to bring back for approval.

Ruth Miller, resident, addressed the Council stating that she attended the meeting in April regarding the timing on the traffic light at Wilters Street and explained that the timing is still bad. She mentioned that once you do get through the light, you still cannot get out onto Highway 59 going south at the next corner, especially if someone is parked in front of the business there. Mrs. Miller mentioned that there are also concerns at the intersection in front of the High School and Pen Air. Mayor Murphy mentioned that there is a project being finalized now of improvements on Fairground Road that will include turning lanes and more control functions at that traffic light. He mentioned that on Wilters and Highway 59 south, they can refer the issue back to the State to see what can be done, but do not see them putting a traffic light at that location. Mrs. Miller stated that there are so many people that go through the yellow light and red light that don't even slow down. After further discussion, Mayor Murphy stated that they will follow-up with the State on these traffic issues.

Councilmember Campbell asked what company hit the gas line on Memorial Day, and Mayor Murphy stated that he thought it was C Spire installing fiber.

Councilmember Hollingsworth asked if the Jennifer Claire More Foundation was going to have the rodeo at the coliseum again, and Mayor Murphy mentioned that they were.

There being no further business to come before the Council, motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, seconded by Councilmember Campbell, with unanimous approval to adjourn. Motion carried.

Upon roll call, the following members of the Council were found to be present: Mayor Murphy, Councilmember Kitchens, Cooper, Campbell, Johnson, and Hollingsworth. Absent: None. A quorum being present the meeting proceeded with the transaction of business.

Mayor Murphy presided over the meeting. Shannon Burkett served as secretary. Ken Raines, City Attorney was also in attendance.

Mayor Murphy called for any additions or corrections to the minutes presented for approval from the June 3, 2024 meeting. Motion was made by Councilmember Campbell, seconded by Councilmember Johnson, with unanimous approval to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. Motion carried.

Mayor Murphy asked for questions or comments regarding the bills presented for approval. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked about the Amphitheater site work item for \$262,116.22. Mayor Murphy explained that this was from Mike Hoffman's Equipment for the disposal of the soil that contained gasoline that was found once they removed the fuel tank. Greg Smith, City Engineer, stated that the testing was sent in to ADEM when completed. With no further discussion, motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Cooper, with unanimous approval to accept the bills as presented. Motion carried. APPENDIX I

The next item on the agenda was a donation request from Robertsdale High School NJROTC. Motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, and seconded by Councilmember Cooper, to donate \$1,500 to Robertsdale High School NJROTC. Mayor Murphy asked for any discussion on the motion. Councilmember Campbell asked if the trips were for competition, and Mayor Murphy explained that they have a competition in March of next year. Councilmember Campbell mentioned that they were very helpful to the City for the Vietnam Memorial Wall. With no further discussion, Mayor Murphy called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous to donate \$1,500 to Robertsdale High School NJROTC. Motion carried.

The Council received a copy of Resolution No. 006-2024, awarding the engineering services on the Community Development Block Grant. Stacy McKean, with Grant Management LLC, addressed the Council explaining that they are preparing to submit the application to ADECA for a Community Development Block Grant for sewer rehab, and this year they can apply for \$500,000. She stated that one of the first steps is to get an engineering firm on board for the preliminary engineering work for the preparation of the application. Motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, and seconded by Councilmember Campbell, to adopt Resolution No. 006-2024, awarding the engineering services on the Community Development Block Grant to Civil Southeast LLC. Mayor Murphy asked for any discussion regarding the motion. Councilmember Hollingsworth asked if the City does receive the grant what the matching funds would be. Mrs. McKean stated that there is a ten percent matching funds requirement, so it would be \$50,000.00, but she would be back to another meeting to discuss the actual application and at that time they would approve the match they agree to. With no further discussion, Mayor Murphy called for a vote on the motion, which was unanimous to adopt Resolution No. 006-2024, awarding the engineering services on the Community Development Block Grant to Civil Southeast LLC. Motion carried. APPENDIX II

Tim Mullek was in attendance to address the Council with concerns regarding a truck parked on the corner of Highway 59 North and Ohio Street. Mayor Murphy stated that the owner of the truck is not in violation of any City statute and they have been through this with the owner. Mayor Murphy mentioned that they gave him an opportunity and he moved it, but it could have been towed because of the fire hydrant. Mr. Mullek stated that using the same line of reasoning as the corner of Ivey's at Pennsylvania Street that is yellow striped, that is the same situation at Ohio Street. Mr. Mullek explained that this should be yellow striped. Mayor Murphy mentioned that the City has had some discussion pertaining to this, but this is a State right-of-way. Mr. Mullek stated that the City is at an extreme risk of a lawsuit, the truck has not moved in nine months, and if somebody pulls out there and gets killed, the City is getting sued and the truck owner is getting sued, so just realize that. Mr. Mullek explained that he asked the truck owner around the first of March to move it but he refused to. He stated that it is a safety hazard and needs to be moved back sixty feet. Councilmember Campbell asked if the City can stripe it since it is a State right-of-way, and Mayor Murphy explained that we would have to get it approved by the State. Mr. Mullek stated that he does not understand the problem, and Mayor Murphy explained that one problem is that the City does not have any kind of ordinance that limits the parking downtown. Mayor Murphy assured him that they would work to try to resolve this and understands his concern.

Councilmember Campbell told Mr. Mullek that she appreciates him coming to a meeting and notifying them of this issue. Mr. Mullek stated that if something happens now, the City cannot deny it anymore because it is in the minutes.

There being no further business to come before the Council, motion was made by Councilmember Cooper, seconded by Councilmember Hollingsworth, with unanimous approval to adjourn. Motion carried.
