The City Council of the City of Robertsdale, Alabama, met on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, at 12:00 p.m. at Robertsdale City Hall, that being the date, time, and place for such called meeting.

Mayor Murphy presided over the meeting. Shannon Burkett served as clerk.

It is noted that there was a quorum present, as signified by signatures on the waiver.


The information received from the Baldwin County Board of Registrars on their findings of the thirteen Provisional Ballots that were submitted to them for their decision on the counting of these ballots was provided and reviewed by the Council. The City Clerk explained that out of the thirteen ballots submitted, the Board of Registrars will only allow the counting of nine and has rejected the remaining four. The affidavit envelopes were then removed from the sealed provisional box, and the unqualified envelopes were separated and returned to the box. The nine approved affidavit envelopes were opened, and the secrecy envelopes were removed. The secrecy envelopes were opened, and the City Clerk read the votes aloud for the Councilmembers to log on their individual tally sheet. After this process, the Council all agreed on the total number of Provisional Votes, and that number was added to the Vote Total on Resolution No. 007-2025, which sets out the results of the August 26, 2025, General Municipal Election.

The results on the resolution declare that Jonathan D. Kitchens received a majority of the votes cast, and declared elected to the office of Council Place No. 1. The resolution declares that Jonathan Lynn received a majority of the votes cast, and declared elected to the office of Council Place No. 3. The resolution declares that Danna Overstreet received a majority of the votes cast, and declared elected to the office of Council Place No. 4. It also declares that Paul Hollingsworth received a majority of the votes cast, and declared elected to the office of Council Place No. 5. Therefore, a run-off election will be held on September 23, 2025 for the office of Mayor between Ruthie Campbell and Russell Johnson, and for Council Place No. 2 between Adam Manning and Beth Lores Robinson. A motion was made by Councilmember Kitchens, seconded by Councilmember Hollingsworth, with unanimous approval to adopt Resolution No. 007-2025. Motion carried. APPENDIX

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Robertsdale, Alabama, as follows:






