The City Council of the City of Robertsdale, Alabama, met on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, at 12:00 p.m. at Robertsdale City Hall, that being the date, time, and place for such called meeting.


Mayor Murphy presided over the meeting. Shannon Burkett served as clerk.

It is noted that there was a quorum present, as signified by signatures on the waiver.


The information received from the Baldwin County Board of Registrars on their findings of the five Provisional Ballots that were submitted to them for their decision on the counting of these ballots was provided and reviewed by the Council. The City Clerk reports that the Board of Registrars has approved the counting of all five ballots. The affidavit envelopes were then removed from the sealed provisional box, opened, and the secrecy envelopes were removed. The secrecy envelopes were opened, and the City Clerk read the votes aloud for the Councilmembers to log on their individual tally sheet. After this process, the Council all agreed on the total number of Provisional Votes, and that number was added to the Vote Total on Resolution No. 010-2025, which sets out the results of the September 23, 2025, Municipal Run-Off Election.

The results on the resolution declare that Ruthie Campbell received a majority of the votes cast and was declared elected to the office of Mayor. The resolution declares that Adam Manning received a majority of the votes cast and was declared elected to the office of Council Place No. 2. A motion was made by Councilmember Hollingsworth, seconded by Councilmember Kitchens, with unanimous approval to adopt Resolution No. 010-2025. Motion carried. APPENDIX






